



Gravestone recipe baking

Vexillology

Simon Joseph became interested in vexillologyaka flag collecting—as a student at the University of Notre Dame when a theology professor explained how the flags of the patron saints of England (St. George's red cross on white), Scotland (St. Andrew's white diagonai cross on blue) and Ireland (St. Patrick's red diagonal cross on white) combine to make the iconic Union Jack, Simon, 37, hosted over 120 fellow fans last fall for the North American Vexillogical Association's 57th Annual Meeting in Philadelphia, with a special flag: a blue Liberty Bell atop 13 red and white stripes arranged in a V shape for vexillology.

The ONE BAPTISM is WATER BAPTISM which was commanded by Jesus to be administered to all who believe in Christ and repent of their sins as stated in the great commission (Matthew 28:18-20; Mark 16:16).
